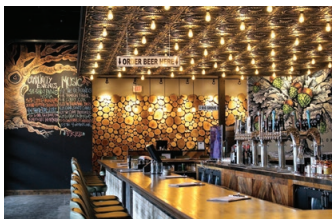

The Post-Race Party is free and open to the public! Food, beverages, and live entertainment will greet runners and spectators near the finish line.

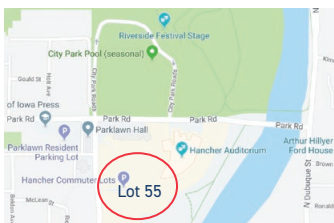

TRACKING RUNNERS ON ROUTE

Runner tracking is available through the Race Day Events app, available for download in the Apple and Android app stores. Search for RUN CRANDIC in the app to track a runner by name or bib number.

Photos will be accessible after the race at runcrandic.com.

CHEER ZONES

Due to the high number of participants and the location of the start lines spectators will not be able to accompany participants at the start line or finish line. These areas will only be accessible to participants displaying their event-issued bib numbers and event staff with proper credentials.

We recommend that spectators support runners from elsewhere on the course and meet runners after the race on the National Czech & Slovak Museum & Library Lawn. Included below are recommended spectator viewing areas.

Iowa City Cheer Zone: Iowa City will cheer the runners on as they ascend the hill on Dubuque Street. Join them on the southeast corner of Dubuque Street and West Overlook Drive.

North Liberty High School: Park in the North Liberty High School lot and join the cheer zone and aid station as runners enter North Liberty.

Penn Elementary School (North Liberty): Join the students and families of Penn Elementary School in North Liberty as they cheer runners on through North Liberty. Parking is available at the elementary school as well as Penn Meadows Park.

Swisher Block Party: The City of Swisher will host a Block Party on the southeast corner of Highway 965 and 120th Street. Spectators, family, and friends are welcome to cheer on runners at the Block Party. There will be a DJ, hot chocolate and coffee from Kava House, and fun! Recommended parking will be in the cemetery lot, located on the northwest corner of Highway 965 and 120th Street NW.

Cedar Rapids Cheer Zone: Spectators can gather at the corner of C St and Bowling St near the finish.
